The first goal of this campaign was to educate the general public regarding the manifestations of Hepatitis B & C and their mode of acquisition and transmission. The second goal was to provide financial support to those suffering from these infections, but unable to afford the expense for their cure. This support will be in terms of medication supplied. Since there is a vaccine available for protection against Hepatitis B, THF is pursuing an immunization program in this regard.

THF Crack for a Hepatitis Free Pakistan

Looking at Hepatitis menace and its urgency, working in community for finding the missing millions, THF has started collaborations with other organizations and initiated **Hepatitis Screening & Treatment Drives** of their employees. THF intends to free an organization from Hepatitis by providing screening and treatment to its employees.



On August 12th and 13th, 2021, the first activity took place at **ATCO Laboratories Limited** where approx. 900 employees were screened.



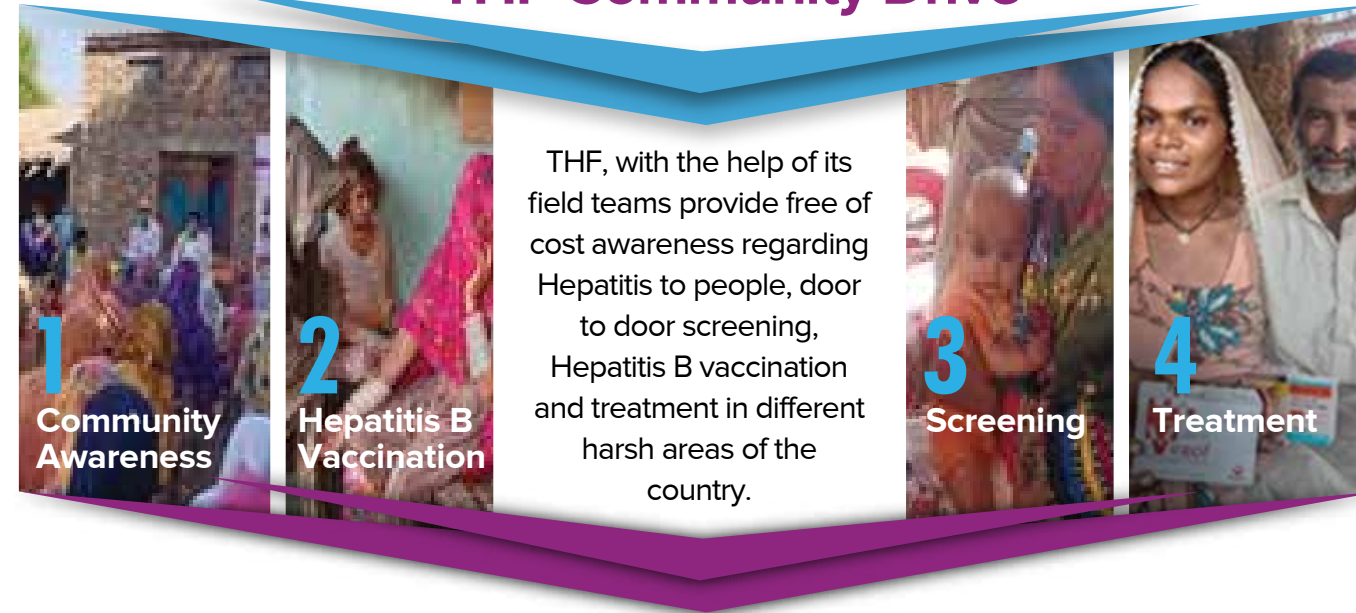
PharmEvo Pvt. Ltd. was the second who participated in this activity on September 2, 2021 and approx. 420 employees were provided with the screening facility.



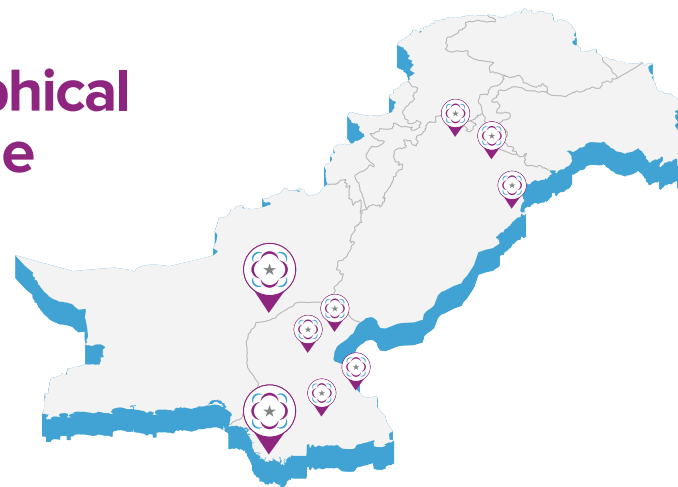
The drive at **Crescent Steel & Allied Products Limited** was conducted on September 7, 2021. 130 employees were screened.

Fateh Shah belongs to a down trodden village of District Sanghar, Sindh. He was fighting with liver pain for a couple of months. He left hope after consulting many doctors in nearby city of Sanghar. One of his friends told him about THF and asked him to visit THF center in same vicinity. During screening he was found positive with Hepatitis C and treated for six months. He defeated this deadliest disease and happily living with his family.

Arfa belongs to a small and underprivileged, village of district Tando Allahyar in Sindh province. She had been feeling fatigue, body pain and laziness for a couple of years due to which she was unable to perform her routine chores at home. Day by day, her health was going down and towards severity but she was unable to consult to a doctor. Fortunately, THF team, during the community screening found her positive of Hepatitis C and provided free of cost treatment for three months including lab tests and medicine. Today, she is one of the Hepatitis survivors and can do all her daily routine work.

THF & Roche MOU

THF and Roche Diagnostics Pakistan officially signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to improve access to reliable diagnostics solutions for the timely detection and treatment of Hepatitis C patients from low-income households, across Pakistan.
