



Al Karam Towel Industry

On **July 12th, 2025** on the request of **Al Karam Towel Industry**, we conducted a **Hep C Awareness & Screening** session at their factory. 50 mid-level members of their management were present.



Patel Hospital

On **July 11th**, **Patel Hospital** conducted a **Hepatitis C screening camp** for 120 walk-in customers. THF provided them with Hepatitis C screening kits and human resources for this successful camp.



Pakistan Navy Dockyard

From **July 14th – July 18th**, THF screened approximately **695 Pakistan Navy dockyard workers for Hepatitis C**. For security reasons, this exercise was organized by PN and carried out at PNS Shifa Hospital. This was a follow-up to a presentation made by Dr. Huma Qureshi on Hepatitis C to both senior and junior naval officers at the PN dockyard in June, 2025.



Hepatitis Screening in Tando Allahyar

With support from TFH UK, THF resumed **Hepatitis B and C screening in UC Shah Inayat Rizvi, Tando Allahyar**. Over 14,520 people have been screened since July 2025, with **666 testing positive for Hepatitis C**. THF also provided new lab equipment and will begin work in UC Ghulam Khan Sanjrani in October 2025.



Lady Dufferin Hospital

On September 16th, THF conducted a **Hepatitis B & C awareness and screening session for 62 new midwifery students at Lady Dufferin School** all tested negative. Such sessions are vital to ensure healthcare workers stay informed and protected from HBV and HCV.



Health Expo 2025

THF participated in the **Health Expo on July 22nd, 23rd, and 24th**. Free screening for Hep C was provided to any person who requested it. **Over 300 were screened for both Hep B & C**. Three of these turned out to be Hep C positive. Their blood was drawn for PCR testing. One turned out to be negative on the PCR test, one had been treated for Hep C in the past, and the third requested her report to get treated on her own.
